

EXTREMELY IMPORTANT WARNING, THE FUTURE OF MANKIND RELIES ON YOUR COMPLIANCE

Before installing the BearExtender Turbo 10.12 Sierra beta package, you must remove any previous version of BearExtender software on your Mac. To do this, first download the BearExtender software for the version of Mac OS you were running before upgrading to Sierra.

For example, if you were previously running 10.11 El Capitan download the 10.11 El Capitan software from our web site, run the uninstall/removal package inside, then install the Sierra beta.

If you were previously running 10.10 Yosemite, download the 10.10 Yosemite software from our web site, run the uninstall/removal package inside, then install the Sierra beta.

If you have done a completely clean install of Sierra erasing all old hard drive contents, or this is a brand new Mac that has never had BearExtender software installed on it, then you do not need to run any uninstaller and can proceed to install the Sierra beta now.
